



<p>SC 1001</p>	<p>The Superintendent shall be the chief administrative and executive officer of the Turkeyfoot Valley Area School District and shall function as the educational leader, giving direction to the total educational program of the schools of the area.</p>
<p>SC 510</p>	<p>The Superintendent shall be responsible for the preparation of administrative guidelines for the operation of the school district that are not inconsistent with state and federal statutes or regulations; are dictated by the policies of this Board; are binding on district employees and students when issued.</p>
<p>Act 170 of 1978 65 P.S. 404</p>	<p>The Superintendent shall be delegated the authority to take necessary action in circumstances not provided for in Board policy, provided that such action be reported to the Board at the next meeting.</p>
<p>SC 510, 1126 Et seq</p>	<p>The Superintendent shall implement a procedure to inform Board members and designated employees of their responsibility under the Ethics Law.</p> <p>Section 3. <u>Review</u></p>
<p>2Pa. C.S.A. Sec. 551 et seq</p>	<p>The Board may assume jurisdiction over controversies or disputes arising within this school district concerning any matter over which the Board has authority granted by statute or where the Board has retained jurisdiction in contract or policies.</p>
	<p>In furtherance of its adjudicatory function, the Board may hold hearings in accordance with law, which shall offer the parties to a dispute, on notice duly given, a fair and impartial forum for the resolution of the matter.</p> <p>Beyond the basic requirements of due process, a hearing may vary in form and content in line with the severity of the consequences that may flow from it, the difficulty of establishing findings of fact from conflicting evidence, and the impact of the Board's decision on the school district.</p>
