## 202.1 ASSIGNMENT AND TRANSFER OF PUPILS

1. Pupils will be assigned by the Principal to the school approved by the Superintendent who shall have the final authority to assign or reassign pupils to other schools when such transfers are deemed desirable. All records for the pupil being transferred shall be submitted to the Principal's Office, from which they will be forwarded to the proper building.
2. Pupils may be transferred by the appropriate principal from one room to another whenever necessary by reason of promotion, overcrowding, or other reason as the Superintendent may authorize.
3. The alternate decision concerning admission will rest with the Superintendent.
  - a. Pupils living outside the District will be considered on a tuition basis if adequate space is available.
  - b. Pupils being admitted from outside the District must present evidence of satisfactory conduct in the past.
4. Names of all pupils enrolling in the District from children's homes or foster homes whose legal residence is outside of the School District shall be reported immediately by the Principal to the Superintendent's office.
5. Affidavits shall be secured from the legal representative of any student whose residence is in question. This shall be presented to the Superintendent.
6. Tuition students will be accepted on an individual basis at 25% of the most current State Tuition Rate. These will be children residing outside the School District. Parents of these students will be required to provide one ninth of the calculated tuition in advance of registration with this District. Monthly payments will be made to the District Treasurer in advance of that month. Any student or parent of said student who is more than twenty days behind in his/her payments will be dropped from the schools rolls.
7. Only pupils who are legal residents of the Turkeyfoot Valley Area School District shall attend without charge to the parent or student. The following definitions will be used in determining legal residence.
  - a. Residence – a factual place of abode. Living in a particular locality.
  - b. Legal Residence – An actual dweller in a place, notwithstanding technical domicile elsewhere, has legal residence.
  - c. Domicile- The place where a man has his true, fixed and permanent home and principle establishment and to which whenever he is absent has the intention of returning.
  - d. A person can have more than one residence, but only one legal residence or domicile.
  - e. Every person has at all times one domicile and no person has more than one domicile at a time.
